



Covid19 House Rules!

From Monday 14th September the 'Rule of 6' will become enforceable in law. To ensure we are Covid19 secure and to help you understand the part you play in helping us maintain a safe place for everyone, we have the following rules in place:

Table Reservations Recommended

Due to reduced capacity, please call or book online in advance.

Outside tables are on a first come, first served basis.

Maximum number of guests to a table is 6 (from any number of households) We are permitted to host larger numbers in total, but groups of up to 6 must not mix or form larger groups.

One-Way System

Please follow the floor markings and keep at least 2m apart from anyone outside of your table.

The tables and chairs have been placed to adhere to social distancing guidelines, so **please refrain from moving them.**

Table Service

Please stay seated at your table as much as possible and refrain from coming to the bar. Whether you are inside or outside, we will take your order at the table & bring your food and drinks to you, so you can sit back and enjoy your visit. All guests must be seated-it is not permitted to be standing anywhere on the premises.

Outside Space

When outside on our premises, you must also be seated and can continue to meet up in groups of up to 6 people from any number of households. **You must comply with social distancing guidelines at all times and maintain a distance of 2m from anyone outside of your 'Rule of 6'.**

Washrooms

We are operating a one in, one out system. The main door to each washroom has been fitted with a lock to show whether the washroom is vacant or engaged. Please ensure you lock the door on entering and sanitise your hands both before and after visiting the washroom.

Wash/Sanitise Your Hands

Hand sanitisers are available for you to regularly sanitise your hands. They are located at the front and rear doors and at the entrance to the washrooms.

Face Masks/Coverings

All members of our front of house staff will be wearing face masks during their shifts. It is not compulsory for our guests to wear face masks, but we welcome them should you chose to do so.

Card Payments

We are only accepting card payments at this time.

Families Welcome

We respectfully remind customers with children that they are responsible for supervising them at all times and should follow social distancing guidelines.

Cleanliness Policy

There are extra cleaning standards in place including regular sanitising of touchpoints, tables and chairs. The washrooms will be cleaned and sanitised every hour.

NHS Track & Trace

As part of the NHS Track & Trace service, it is a legal requirement that we must take contact details from all of our guests and retain them for 28 days. There are posters on display throughout the pub showing a QR code. Please scan this code and enter your details as requested.
